STORAGE BUILDING REQUIREMENTS

Oak Park Deeds & Restrictions state that outbuildings are subject to approval of Oak Park Homes Association. The Oak Park Homes Association has developed a policy to allow a permanent storage structure, subject to it being attached to the house (no gap between house and structure) clad, painted, and roofed the same as the house. If these criteria are met, the outbuilding will look like an addition to the house rather than a free-standing unit in the back yard.

Some smaller, temporary, movable storage units can be approved if the unit meets the approval of the OPHA Board. These smaller units are not expected to remain with the property upon transfer of the deed to a new owner. These smaller units need to be located on the back side of the house, located on a hard level surface.
